


Web Portal User Manual






### **Step 1: Accessing Schedules Section**



- Navigate to the "Schedules" section of Sprybe web portal.
- The page displays a calendar view for the current month, showcasing existing schedules.


### **Step 2: Navigating Calendar Views**



- Use navigation options to:
  - Navigate to the previous or next with respect to the view.
  - Change the view to Weekly, Daily, or Agenda view.




#### Step 3: Creating a New Schedule



• Click the "Create" button to access the schedule creation page.


#### Step 4: Schedule Creation Form





- Fill in the schedule creation form with the following details:
  - Schedule Name
  - Start Date, Start Time, End Date, End Time
  - All day Toggle: Activating the "All day" toggle indicates that the schedule will occur throughout the entire duration of the selected day.
  - Use Absolute Time Checkbox: Check to set absolute time. Click the info icon for additional information.
  - Time zone: If absolute time is selected, choose the required time zone.



#### Step 4: Schedule Creation Form 2










- When creating a schedule, users will be able to set a recurrence pattern for the event. The recurrence dropdown offers several options to specify how often the event should repeat
  - Doesn't Repeat: This option indicates that the event will not be repeated and is a one-time occurrence.
  - Every Weekday: Selecting this option will schedule the event to occur every Monday through Friday.
  - Daily: Choosing daily recurrence will schedule the event to repeat every day.
  - Weekly: Users can select this option to schedule the event to repeat every week on specific days. Upon selection, users will be prompted to set the recurrence pattern in a modal
  - Monthly: This option allows users to schedule the event to repeat every month on a specific day or date. Users will be prompted
- Selecting a recurrence option other than "Doesn't Repeat" will generate a schedule series, automatically creating multiple instances of the event according to the specified recurrence pattern.

#### Step 5: Orientation and Playlist Selection




- Select the desired Orientation.
- Choose playlists from the list enabled based on the orientation. On the right side, change the playlist order by dragging them up or down using the drag handle.
- Within the selected playlist section of the application, users can initiate a preview of the playlist content by clicking the designated play button. This action launches a modal window specifically for playlist preview, enabling users to visualize and assess the content before scheduling or publishing it.




**Step 6: Device Selection** 



- Select devices from the list enabled based on the orientation.
- The next section shows the selected devices and their corresponding schedules for the day to avoid conflicts.

### **Step 7: Save Changes**




• Click the "Create" button to save the schedule. The schedule will be added to the calendar view.




**Step 8: Editing Schedule** 



- The newly created schedule is shown in the calendar view.
- When viewing a particular schedule, users are presented with two options for editing.


Step 9: Editing Schedule - Edit occurrence



- Clicking "Edit occurrence" directs the user to the schedule's occurrence page.
- Any modifications made here will only affect the selected occurrence of the schedule




### Step 10: Editing Schedule - Edit Series



- Clicking on "Edit series" navigates the user to the series page of the schedule
- Modifications made here will affect the entire series, including all occurrences associated with it.

#### Step 11: Delete Schedule



- Delete the schedule by clicking the delete button in the bottom right corner.
- To delete a schedule, click the delete button. A modal will appear, and you need to enter the schedule name accurately to confirm the delete operation.
