

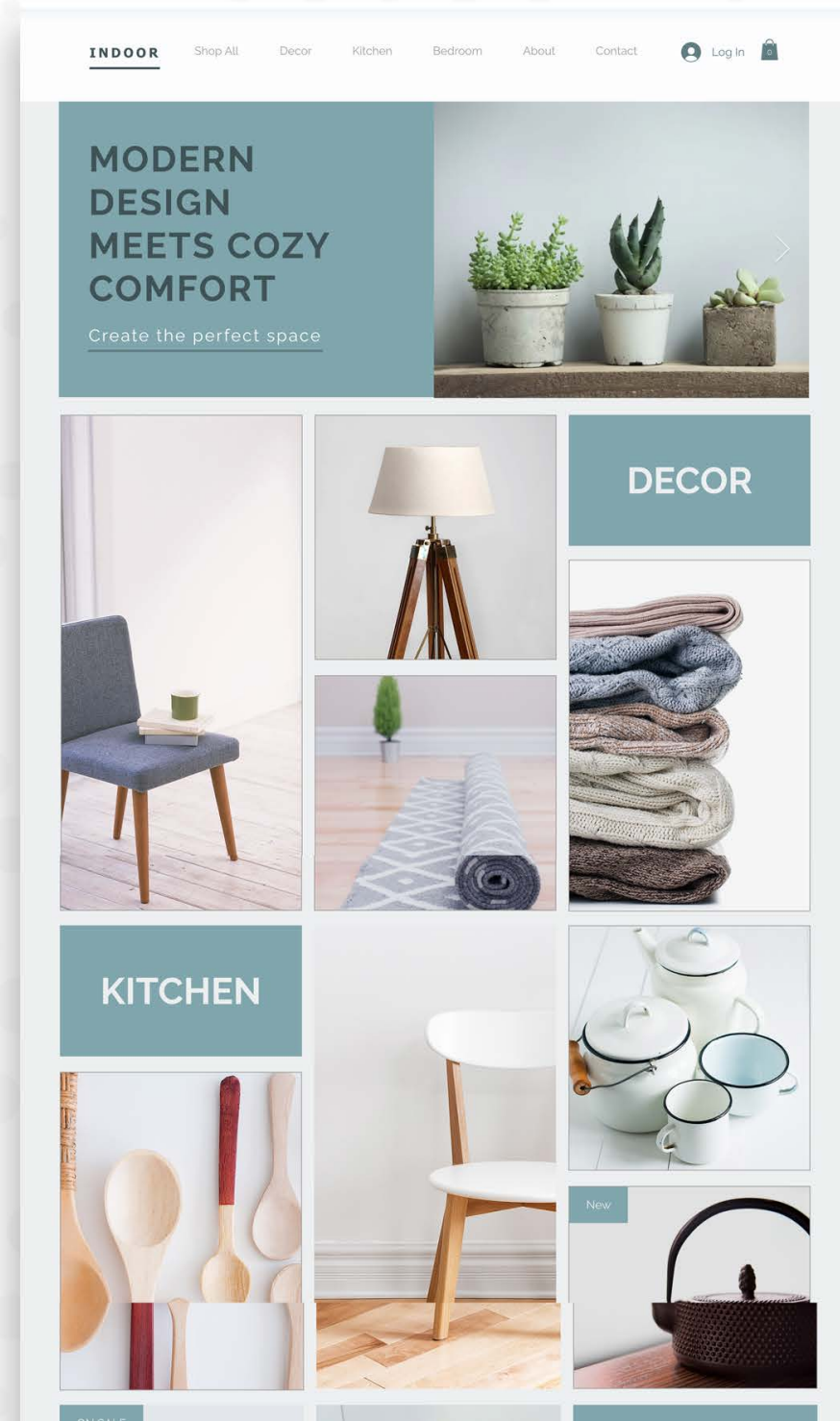

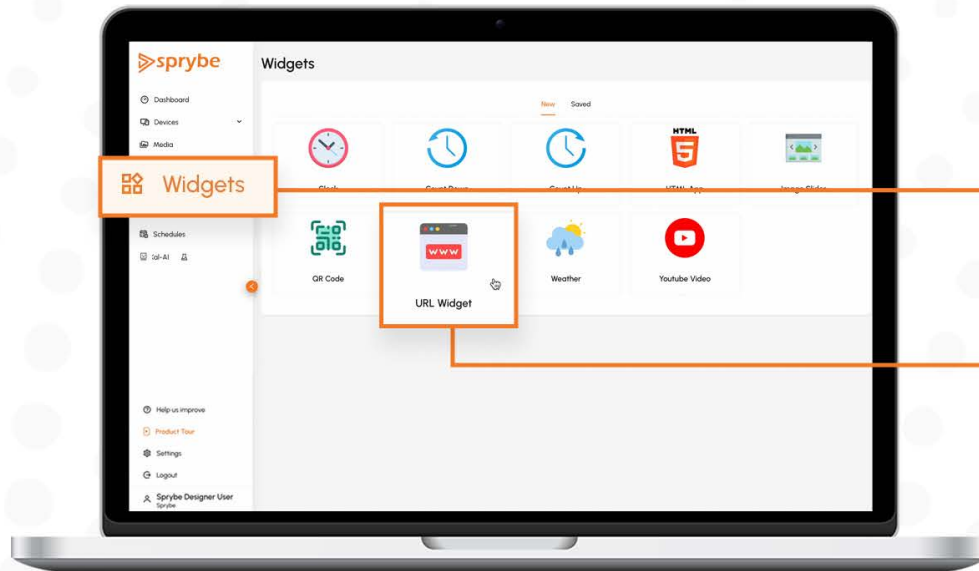
URL Widget

The URL Widget lets you easily display live web content on your digital signage screens. With a few clicks, showcase real-time websites, interactive dashboards, or dynamic online content—keeping your screens fresh and engaging. Whether it's analytics, live updates, or branded experiences, the widget ensures seamless, always up-to-date integration.

In this example, we're displaying a **home decor website** to demonstrate how effortlessly web pages can be embedded into the signage layout.

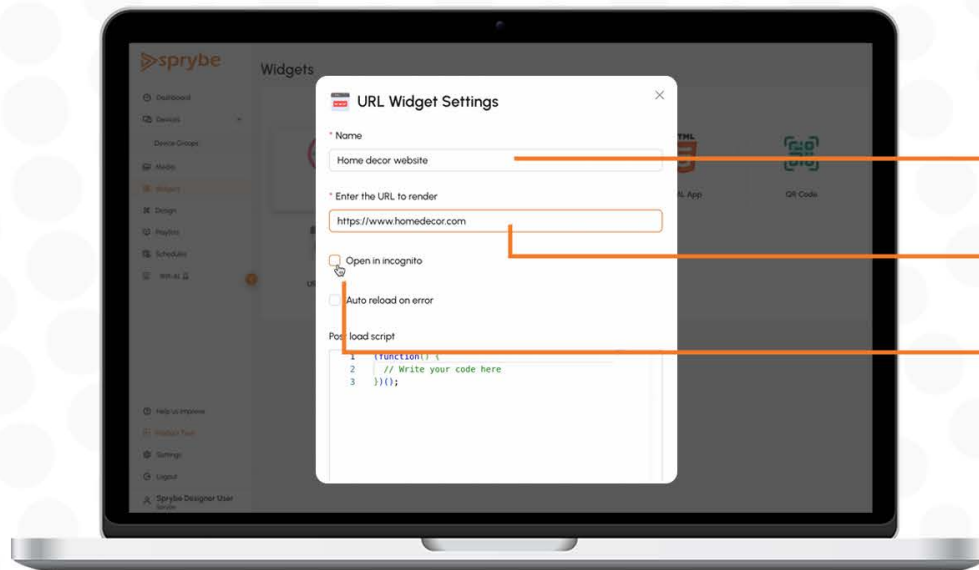


Step 1: Selecting a URL Widget



- In the left-hand menu, click on “Widgets”.
- From the list of available widgets, choose “URL Widget”.

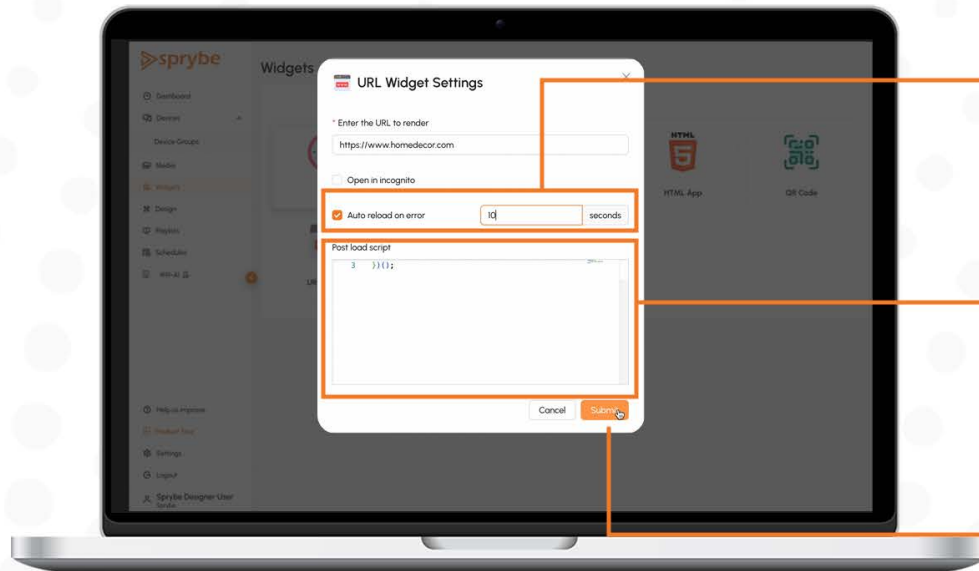
Step 2: Configure URL Widget Settings



A URL Widget Slider settings modal will appear. Complete the following:

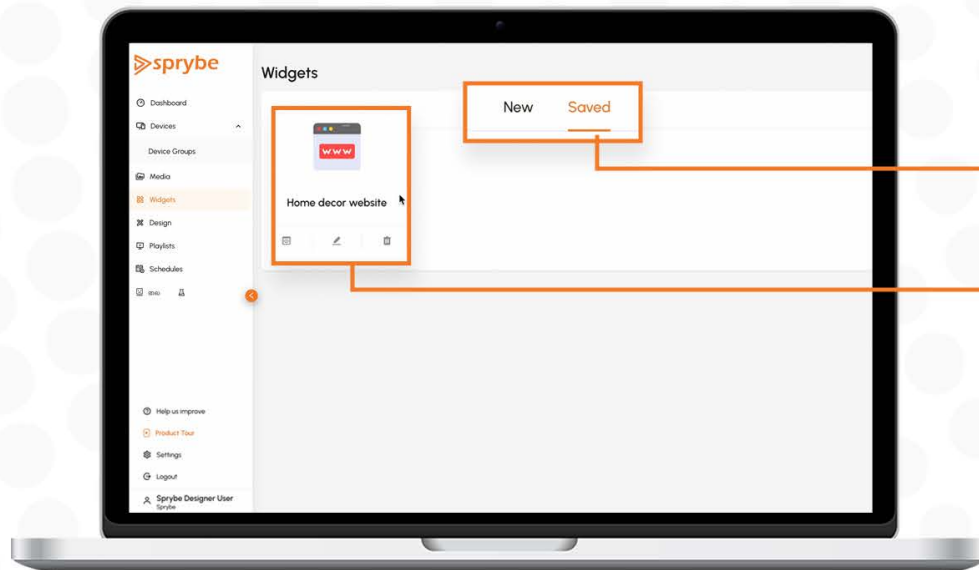
- **Name:** Enter a name for your widget.
- Input the desired URL that you want to render in the widget.
- Check the "Open in Incognito" checkbox if you want the URL to open in an incognito session.

Step 3: Configure URL Widget Settings & Save Widget



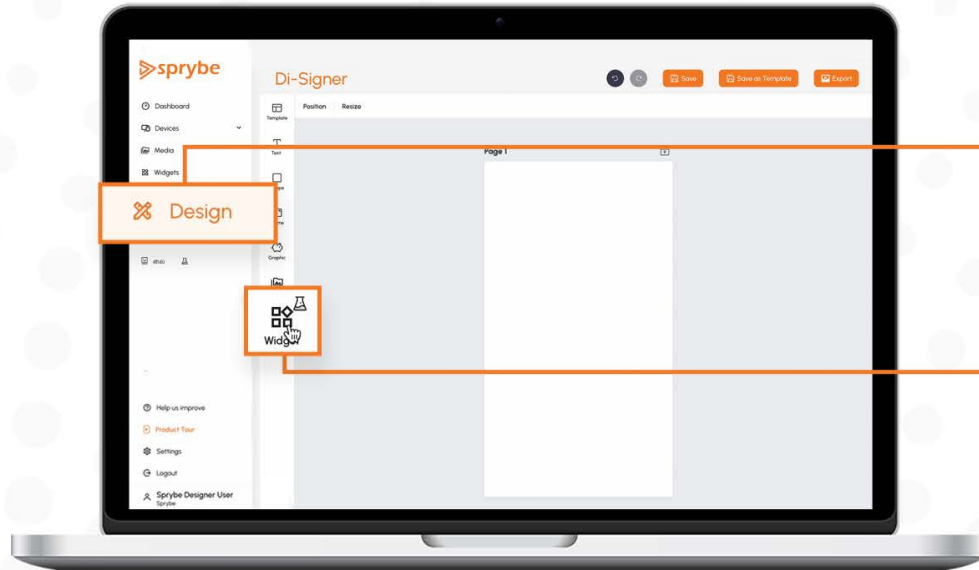
- Turn on the "Auto Reload on Error" option if you want the widget to automatically reload the URL upon encountering an error. Specify the reload interval in seconds. (Optional)
- You can include a post-load script that runs after the URL is loaded. This is useful for tasks like auto-login or triggering specific actions once the page appears. (Optional)
- Click "Submit"

Step 4: Saved tab



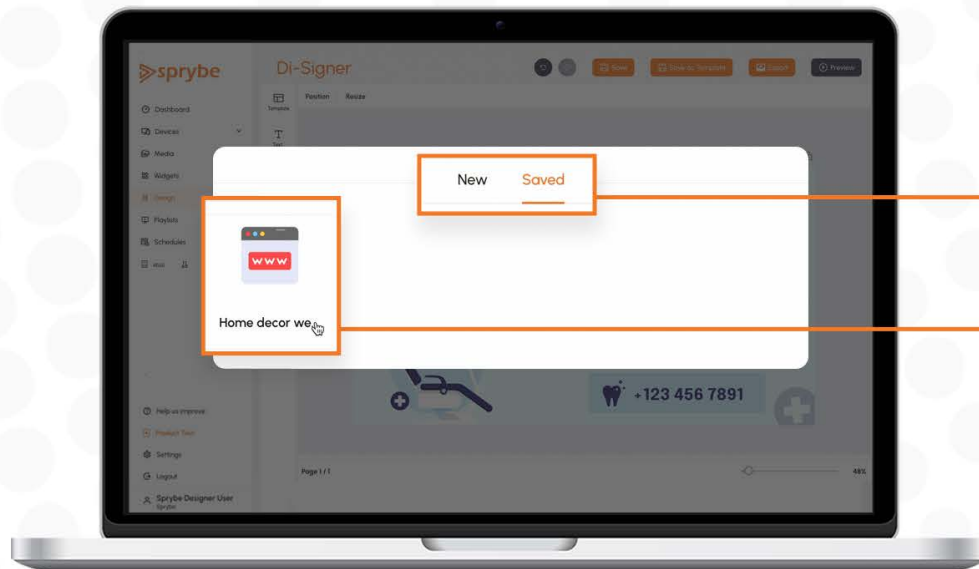
- Go to the Saved tab to view your saved widgets.
- Here, you can edit, view, or delete any widget.

Step 5: Add the URL Widget to a Design



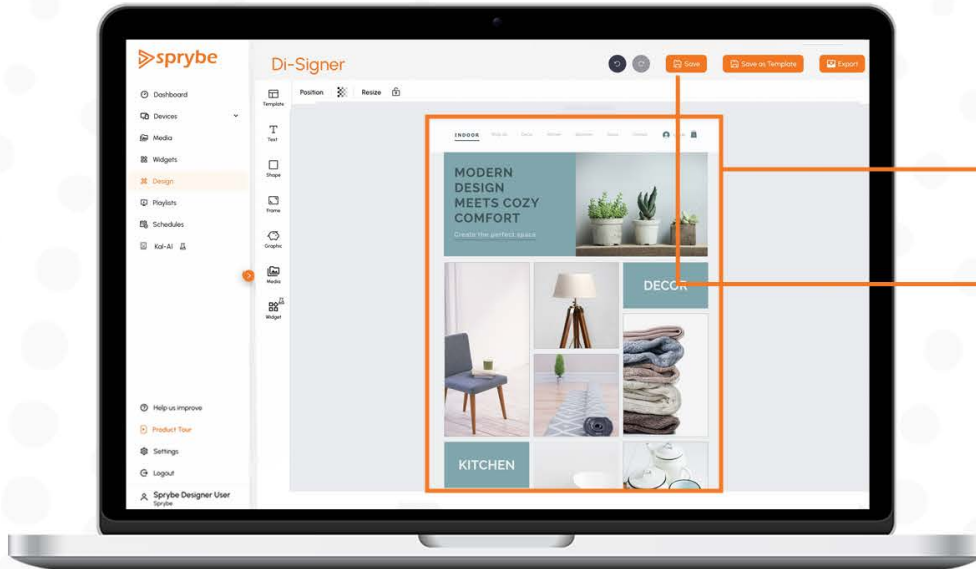
- Open the Design Section
- Choose a design template or create one.
- Select Widget in the left panel.

Step 6: Saved tab



- Navigate to the Saved tab and select your saved URL Widget.

Step 7: Add the URL Widget to a Design



- Resize and reposition it as needed.
- Save your design.

Step 8: Publish to your Screen

- Add the design to a playlist.
- Publish to your screen to display the configured URL on your selected screen.
